Application deadline will be 2:00 p.m. (CDT) on Friday, June 25, 2021.

Thank you for your interest in a career with the Village of Skokie Police Department. The following is intended to provide **general information regarding the Village of Skokie's Police Officer Recruitment Process.**

Testing is typically conducted every two years.

At the time of the written examination, all individuals interested in becoming a Police Officer must meet the following **Minimum Requirements:**

- Pay a \$35.00 non-refundable application fee;
- Minimum of 21 years of age and under 35 years of age at the time of the written examination **(07/24/21)**;
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S.;
- High School diploma or equivalent **and** ONE of the following:
 - Minimum of **sixty (60) college semester hours** from an accredited institution by the application deadline date **(06/25/21)**;
OR
 - Four (4) years of active military service with an Honorable Discharge by the application deadline date **(06/25/21)**;
- Possess a valid Driver's License;
- Proof of completion of Peace Officer Wellness Evaluation Report (POWER) test with attainment date less than six (6) months **prior** to the written exam (**valid only if issued between 01/23/21 – 07/23/21**);

 - Note: In case of demonstrated financial hardship, accommodations can be made regarding the Application and POWER testing fee. Contact the Village's Human Resources Office for details;
- Strict compliance with the Skokie Police Department Appearance Policy, specifically Article IV (Tattoos/Branding/Intentional Scarification/Body Art and Mutilation/Body Piercing) – please see Appearance Policy included at the end of the application packet or call IO Solutions;
- Have correctable vision to 20/20 and be able to distinguish colors;
- Within 24 months from hire, reside in Cook, Lake, or DuPage County in Illinois;
- Enter into an "Authorization for Release of Personal Information Agreement"
- Enter into an "Employment of Relatives Agreement"
 - **NOTE:** Applicants with relatives who are currently employed with the Village **MAY NOT** be eligible for hire – please see policy included in the agreement.
- Enter into an "Abstinence of Tobacco Products Agreement";
- Enter into a "Candidate Reimbursement Agreement";
- Sign the Skokie Police Department Personal Appearance Acknowledgement Form
- Must have ability to comprehend the English Language (written and spoken);
- Completion and submission of Village of Skokie Public Safety Application and other required documents to IO Solutions by **2:00 p.m. (CDT) on Friday, June 25, 2021.**

Application and other required documents **WILL NOT** be accepted at the Skokie Police Dept., Skokie Village Hall, or other Village of Skokie buildings. **The Village of Skokie is an Equal Opportunity Employer.**
