

# **RESIDENTS - READ BEFORE DROPPING OFF BATTERIES**

Primary/Single-Use batteries cannot be recharged and must be disposed or recycled once they wear out to include Alkaline, lithium, silver oxide, zinc-air, zinc-carbon, zinc-chloride and CR/SR/LR (button batteries).

Products that may use or contain primary/single-use batteries: Flashlights, Clocks & Watches, Smoke Detectors, Remote Controls, Toys, and more.

## **How to Identify What Type of Battery You Have**

- **Read the Label** to determine the battery's chemistry!
- **Lithium Batteries:** Terminal ends must be taped with electrical or duct tape, put in a plastic bag and place in the designated collection box – *For Lithium Batteries Only*.
- Alkaline and other batteries listed above should be placed in a separate designated collection box.
